



For Bishops and Vocation Directors: Communicating Your Visit to SJV

Travel Logistics

When planning your visit to SJV, please send the following travel details to your diocesan lead seminarian and to Savannah Siegler, Fr. Kelly's assistant (ssiegler@sjvseminary.org):

- If you are flying, please provide your flight numbers and departure and arrival times. If you would like to arrange a ride from the airport or prefer a rental car, please let us know. (Parking is available at SJV.)
- If you are driving, provide your estimated time of arrival and indicate whether you will need an SJV parking space.

Arrival and Check-In

If you are staying at SJV and arrive during business hours (8 am to 4:30 pm), your key and a welcome folder will be waiting for you at the front office. A seminarian from your diocese will be there to greet you and show you to your room.

If you are staying at SJV and plan to arrive after business hours (4:30 pm or later), please coordinate with your diocesan lead seminarian for building and room access.

If you are not staying at SJV but at Frey Hall, stop by SJV first so a seminarian can give you your welcome folder and room key and help you find where to go.

Please let Savannah Siegler know whether you are staying at The Saint Paul Seminary or have made other housing arrangements.

Meetings with Seminarians

If you would like to schedule one-on-one meetings with your seminarians, please coordinate with your diocesan lead seminarian to arrange them. He will share that information with Savannah, who will ensure a private space is available for you to meet.

Other Considerations

Your diocesan lead will coordinate with you on meals and concelebration of the liturgy.

If you would like to bring prospective seminarians, we recommend attending our scheduled Vianney Visits, as those weekends are designed to provide the fullest SJV experience. If the upcoming Vianney Visit dates do not work with your schedule and you want to bring prospective seminarians, please make your request to Savannah, and she will check with our formation team to see if it is possible.
