



For Diocesan Seminarian Lead: Organizing Your Bishop or Vocation Director SJV Visit

First things first: Whenever you communicate with your bishop or vocation director about a visit to SJV, please let Savannah Siegler (ssiegler@sjvseminary.org) and Mike Roesch (mroesch@sjvseminary.org) know.

When vocation directors, bishops, or priests on official SJV business visit the seminary:

- 1) Get flight numbers (if applicable) and arrival/departure times from Savannah.
- 2) Arrange for an SJV seminarian, usually from your diocese, to pick up your guest at the airport and drop him off when he departs.
- 3) If your guest arrives after hours (4:30 pm or later), arrange for you or another seminarian, usually from your diocese, to let him in and welcome him.
- 4) If your guest is not staying at SJV but is staying in Frey Hall, you can obtain his room key from the front office.
- 5) If asked, arrange one-on-one meetings with the SJV seminarians from your diocese. Spiritual direction rooms and the flex office are typically available. Coordinate with Savannah to reserve the space.
- 6) Coordinate a meal together with your guest. If using the Upper Room, please reserve it through Suzanne Sterr (ssterr@sjvseminary.org) in the front office.
You will be responsible for ensuring the Upper Room is cleaned after the evening.
- 7) Contact the Director of Liturgy to let him know whether visiting priest(s) will concelebrate Mass that day. *Note that for visiting bishops, the Office of the Rector will handle this step.*
- 8) When your guest arrives, if you are not in class or busy with official seminary business, be sure to greet him in the lobby and ask if there's anything you can do to help him get settled.

When vocation directors are bringing prospective seminarians along with them:

- 1) Get a list of the men's names and ages from Savannah Siegler.
- 2) Coordinate with Savannah to arrange rooms for the men to stay in while visiting SJV, as minors need different accommodations than those over 18.
